HAREWOOD GOLF CLUB BY-LAWS

1. CLUB COLOURS

The Colours of the Club shall be RED and BLUE

2. GREEN FEE PLAYERS

- (a) Members introducing Green Fee players shall be responsible for their visitor's conduct while on the Club's property. Such members will also be responsible for any debts incurred.
- (b) Visiting officers of other clubs may be invited as guests of the Club by the President, Board members or either of the captains, provided that the Professional and/or the Match Convenor of the day are advised that any such guest/s are playing on the course.
- (c) Any member of the Board or Life Member may invite a guest to play on the course, but such privilege shall not be used more than three times in any one year, with advice given as in Clause 2 (b).

3. GREENS STAFF

Greens Staff carrying out their duties shall have right of way on the course at all times.

4. COURSE CONTROL

- (a) The responsibility for course closure rests with the Course Superintendent in consultation with the General Manager and Club Captains of the day.
- (b) The formulations and implementation of Local Rules, including Placing, rests with the Match Committee.

5. COMPLAINTS

All complaints about Club employees or other members shall be made in writing to the General Manager.

GENERAL HOUSE RULES

Dress

As in most clubs, it is essential that a good standard of dress be maintained. Members are therefore expected to observe the following rules in the proper spirit and ensure that their dress is always appropriate. Minimum standard is neat and tidy dress.

Members who invite visitors to the club should ensure they are aware of the rules and dress requirements.

Food & Liquor

Only food and liquor purchased from the clubhouse may be consumed on the premises.

Membership Card

All members must carry their membership card whilst on the course.

ETIQUETTE OF THE GAME OF GOLF (Condensed from Section 1 of the Rules of Golf)

Safety

Ensure no one is likely to be injured as a result of your play.

Consideration for Others

- · The person with the honour plays first.
- · Do not move or talk whilst others are playing shots.
- · Play without undue delay.
- · Do not hit up on players in front.
- Call the following group through if a ball is likely to be difficult to find.
- · Immediately leave the green once the hole is completed.
- · Keep pace with the group in front.

Priority on the Course

- A single player has no standing and should give way to any match.
 Any match playing a full round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round.
- · If you lose a fairway, call the following group through.

Care of the Course

- · Rake bunkers.
- · Replace divots.
- · Repair ball marks on greens.
- · Repair spike marks on greens (after putting out).
- · Take care with flagsticks.
- · Do not cause damage with practice swings.
- · Observe rules regulating movement of golf carts and trundlers.

KNOWLEDGE OF RULES OF GOLF

It is the duty of each and every member to acquire a proper knowledge of the rules of golf and also the local rules. New members should have an understanding of these rules before being awarded a handicap. Rule books may be obtained from the office during business hours 8:30am - 5:00pm Monday to Friday.

LOCAL RULES

Members should become familiar with those as appear on the back of the scorecard and before commencing play check the board by the pro shop for any additions or alterations to the rules. Players must wait for the signal from a greenkeeper working on a green or the fairway before playing up. Players must wait until greenkeepers cutting fairways are out of range before playing.

During the months of May to September the course may be closed due to frost. When this occurs, play is to commence only when advised by the Course Superintendent. All players must report to the Pro Shop before commencing play.

CARDS FOR HANDICAPPER

All cards should be returned even though a player may have incurred disqualification or has failed to complete the round. Cards must be completed correctly and fully with name, date, computer number and handicap details.

Corporate Membership

Playing rights according to their respective full playing men's / women's rights and agreed priorities.

(FULL PLAYING AND JUNIORS) Unrestricted playing rights every day (Subject to the list following)

SUMMER MEMBERSHIP (1 OCT - 31 MARCH)

Unrestricted playing rights every day from 1 Oct to 31 Mar subject to the list following.

WINTER MEMBERSHIP (1 APRIL - 30 SEPTEMBER)

Unrestricted playing rights every day from 1 April – 30 September subject to the list following.

Limited to 9 holes per day on days set by the match committee. Any member wishing to play 18 holes must pay green fees for the additional 9 holes. Unrestricted playing rights subject to the list below.

Full Playing members. All players playing prior to 1pm must pay the relevant entry fee for the Men's or Women's competition of the day. Women may play at any time in the field, or join the designated morning or afternoon groups, except on LGU days when a player must play in one of the designated groups. Juniors may compete in Saturday competitions only if the Match Committee has granted match-playing rights.

Sunday Juniors - Designated tee times only

All rights as above subject to programme details as printed or course bookings.

GREEN FEE PLAYERS

Green fee players may play at any time subject to members' rights. Where the course is reserved at weekends the course will not be available over the period of the reservation unless by arrangement.

MEMBERS RIGHTS TO BRING VISITORS

Members are welcome to bring visitors at any time the member has playing rights provided the visitor is introduced to the starter and after paying the requisite green fee. However, members may not bring a visitor to play in the Saturday competition unless he is a member of an affiliated golf club and prior arrangement has been made with the Club Captain or General Manager.

HOLE IN ONE POLICY

Introduction:

The club will insure financial members for hole in one 'shouts'. This is to the maximum value of \$100 and is recognised at any golf club affiliated to New Zealand Golf.

Objectives:

To enable members to celebrate with fellow golfers and friends the occasion of a memorable event.

Guidelines:

- The hole in one must be attested by at least one other witnessing player, preferably two.
- To be recognised as a 'Club shout' it must take place in an official organised competition.
- The 'shout' can only be spent on the day of the event at the Club or if the Club is closed for any reason on production of the receipt for one 'shout'.
- If not in an official competition it will be only recognised by the club by way of notification on the hole in one board.
- Bar staff will attend to the arrangements after approval is given from a club official.
- 6. If a Harewood member achieves this feat elsewhere, then the club will reimburse that person for a 'shout' at one venue up to a maximum of \$100 on production of a receipt for expenses, in addition to the attested card.
- All Harewood members who hole in one will have their name recorded on our Honours Board.
- The round does not have to be completed for hole in one recognition.

MEN'S PROGRAMME

General

Invercargill:

- 1. If course is open for golf and weather inclement buy a jacket!
- Members must enter competitions on the understanding they are available to play finals day for all events
- Match play rounds may be adjusted by mutual agreement with the Match Committee and/or Pro Shop. Rounds must be played on or before next scheduled round.
- No Shootout rounds will take place whilst Club Champs qualifying or finals are being played on the same Saturday.

Playing Conditions

- A match committee representative is on duty each Saturday.
 Please refer to that person if necessary.
- The starting time for all Saturday competitions is from 7.00am onwards. In June/July/August play commences on a two-tee start (1 & 10) from 10.00am to 12:00pm.
- All players are to report to the pro shop before proceeding to the tee.

- 4. Saturday: Course closed until 1:00pm for Full Playing members. Saturday Ladies have preferential bookings from 9:00am to 9:45am and 12:15pm to 12:30pm, or as required per the programme. Course booking at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- White tees for Saturday competition unless indicated in the programme or by the Match Committee.
- Handicap grades for competitions are at the discretion of the Match Committee. The Match Committee may allocate any grade or grades of competition to be played on the course without notice, but where possible due notice will be given.
- All competitions are to start from the first tee unless otherwise directed by the Match Committee or Pro Shop.
- Players not prepared to pay the match fee on competition days may not play in competition times.
- 9. Incorrectly completed cards will be disqualified.
- 10. All players should be on the tee at their appointed time. Players who fail to do so will be penalised as per the R&A Rules of Golf, unless the Match Committee is satisfied there were extenuating circumstances. Players in Championship events should be present 10 minutes before their starting time.

Match Play

- When the total number of entries in any grade are less than 32 the Match Committee has the right to reduce the number of qualifiers.
- All match play events will be assigned a starting time in advance but may be played at any time up to and including the day before the next round of the competition.
- Club Championship Finals for Senior & Intermediate grades will be over 36 holes. Junior A & B shall be 18 holes. All other competition finals will be over 18 holes.
- Gross scores are used to determine qualifiers in events where match play is off the stick and net scores are used if the event is handicap match play.
- In handicap match play events handicaps should be declared on the first tee prior to play (Rule 6.1a).
- All reservations and priorities are waived when courses are required for tournaments.
- Check notice board and email communications regularly for alterations to the programme.

MEN - MAJOR EVENTS

Club Championships: Qualifying will be 2 rounds of 3. Players will be required to nominate which 2 rounds they will play and qualify. Entry will be by booking sheet in the Pro Shop opening 3 weeks prior to first round. Stroke play. Four grades. Handicap as per handicap on 1st qualifying round. Maximum 16 qualifiers in Junior, A, B and Intermediate with 8 Senior qualifiers. Finals: Senior & Intermediate 36 holes. Junior A & B 18 holes. Players enter on the premise that they are able to play on Finals Day 25 September.

36 Hole Stroke Championship: Best gross score over 36 holes qualifying in all grades.

Harewood 4BBB - (previously Sponsors Cup): - Men & Women. One qualifying round. Maximum of 32 pairs to qualify by nett over 18 holes. Match play rounds to be played off current handicap. Lowest handicapped player in group plays off scratch, others play off resulting difference. Entry fee applicable.

Monthly Medal: Stroke in three grades plus best gross. Monthly best overall nett gets top dog/cat car park. Monthly winners play final in December.

"The Peninsular Beachfront Resort Men's Shoot Out": Top 19 qualify for shootout. Combined best 6 stableford rounds counted. Entries taken up to mid-March. Flat fee entry. All Saturday competition rounds counted if field is on same tee.

Bell Mugs: Multiple Stableford. Pairs. 18 holes.

Ashby Mugs: Combined Stableford. Pairs. 18 holes.

COMPETITIONS

It is run nationwide over the course of the year and governed by the same conditions throughout New Zealand. There are between 6 and 8 LGU rounds during the year. LGU medals are awarded for the best 4 nett aggregates in each division and LGU buttons for the best netts in each division for that round.

GOLE COMPETITIONS AND HOW THEY ARE PLAYED.

Stroke (Medal): The total number of strokes taken plus any penalty strokes Is entered on the scorecard, totalled at the end of the round and the players full handicap deducted. The competition will be for gross score or for nett score after handicap has been deducted.

Par: Entered on the scorecard the same way as for stroke play but the result of each hole is marked in the column provided with a "+" for a win, an "O" for a half and a "-" for a loss after allowing for handicap stroke.

Stableford: Score of the hole is entered on the card in the same way as for stroke, then stableford points are entered in the column provided for the NETT score on the hole after allowing for handicap strokes (if the player is in receipt of one or more as shown by the stroke index on the card). Points awarded on the nett score are:1 for one over par, 2 for par, 3 for one under par, 4 for two under par, 5 for three under par. At the end of the round the points are totalled to give the players score for the round.

International Stableford: Scoring is based on your nett score on each hole, with points awarded or subtracted as follows: Double eagle, 8 points; eagle, 5 points; birdie, 2 points; par, 0 points; bogey, -1 point; double bogey or worse, -3 points.

Bisque: A par or stableford competition where strokes may be taken up to the limit of the player's handicap at any hole, at the player's discretion before teeing off at the next hole.

Four-ball Stroke: Two players play as partners; each has strokes as indicated on card. Enter both gross scores and best net score of partners on the card. Indicate whose score is used at each hole.

Four-ball Par: Two players play as partners, each taking strokes at holes as in par competition. If one partner wins hole and the other halves it, only the win is recorded. If one halves the hole and the other loses it, only the half is recorded. Indicate whose score is used at each hole.

Foursomes: Two players play as partners and use one ball. The partners play alternatively from the tee and thereafter alternatively during the play of each hole. Handicap allowance is exactly half of the combined.

Canadian Foursome: Both players play the tee shot at every hole and afterwards play alternate shots with whichever ball they nominate. The nominated ball is to be played by the partner, not the owner of the ball.

Handicap is 40% of combined handicaps.

American Foursome (Yankee): Both players play tee shots then play the second shot with their partner's ball. One ball is selected and play proceeds with alternate shots with the owner of the ball selected playing the third shot. Partner with lower course handicap receives 60% of course handicap. Partner with higher course handicap receives 40% of course handicap. Add together, then round off the total.

Greensome: Both players play tee shots and second shots at each hole. One ball is selected and play proceeds with alternate shots. The third shot must be played by the partner, not the owner of the ball. Partner with lower course handicap receives 60% of course handicap. Partner with higher course handicap receives 40% of course handicap. Add together, then round off the total.

Ambrose: Teams consist of up to six players. All players tee off, one shot is selected and the other players, after retrieving their ball, drop it within one club length of selected ball (no nearer the hole) through the green, or within 25 centimetres (placed - no nearer the hole) on the greens until the hole is completed. Only one score is entered on the card. Handicap allowance is determined by number in team. Ladies full handicap, own tees, men's card. When playing in sixes the owner of the ball selected does not play that shot. Note there are many variations to this game.

Hartball Ambrose: Instructions and score sheet will be supplied for game, 4 to 6 person teams

Irish Stableford: Individual game: scoring normal stableford points on holes 1 - 6, x2 points on holes 7 - 12 and x3 points on holes 13 - 18.

Hidden Holes: Round is played and entered in regular stroke or stableford format with the scoring holes for the competition being determined by the Pro Shop upon completion.

Yellow/Coloured Ball Stableford: Played in teams of three or four with each individual scoring their round in normal stableford format. Playing order is determined on the first tee with each player taking it in turns to play the "yellow ball". The team score per hole is the Yellow Ball plus the better ball from the rest of the team. If the Yellow Ball fails to score a stableford point, the team score for the hole is zero.
