GEORGE WALKER, 1935 – 2018

Very few of today's members will be aware of George's unparalleled contribution to Harewood and the broader golf community, over many decades.

As a school boy (5th Form), he and three friends would, on a Saturday, bike around clubs for a game. In those days, as you would imagine their reception was not always welcoming. They were delighted when Harewood, then advertised as a "Young Peoples Club" signed them up. This led to a huge commitment to Harewood, Canterbury and NZ golf.

George was a club champion in Junior ("Junior A George") and Intermediate Grades, as well as Canterbury stroke play champion. He was playing off a five at that stage. However, he was most influential in all aspects of administration. He began on our Committee, soon became Captain, President, and eventually Life Member and Patron. For many years he was fully committed to Canterbury and rose through the ranks in that organisation. He managed several Canterbury Freyberg Cup teams, organised the NZ Amateur held at Russley, and to top it off was responsible for the prestigious Eisenhower event held at Shirley.

In 1982 he established the Presidents Grade, still sitting on the Canterbury calendar and a very popular event for mainly senior golfers.

So, George's contribution to Harewood has never been matched and no doubt over the years, this has enhanced our standing in the golf community.

There was a saying that you knew George was around without seeing him, because

you could certainly hear him!!!

Harewood has lost an outstanding member and the club's greatest ever contributor to golf.
