The dry weather that has been affecting New Zealand over the last 2 months since Christmas was noticeable in the North Island club courses, we played over the last 3 weeks. Some courses, even with fairway watering were dry and burnt out with only a green strip down the middle. It certainly showed me what an asset we have with our own well and ability to water our fairways to keep them in condition through the summer dry months. In reports from other members playing and from Colin the coring of the greens was successful, the weather gods complied with good weather and the greens are recovering as expected. This weekend is a stableford round in the men's and ladies' grade, other than those ladies who wish to play for the Jean Tench trophy and use all irons (no hybrids or rescue woods).
