Matt McLean Update

You may have seen on our Facebook page that Matt has made the National Academy Squad for 2018/19 as a tier 2 player. Only former Harewood Open winner Daniel Hillier is in Tier one. Tier two is the gateway to the National Academy which is for players who have shown great potential but may still have some way to go before

representing New Zealand at senior level or turning professional. They have been identified as emerging talent but they will still have developmental gaps that need to be addressed while they strive to improve their on-course performance's. The Academy also provides funding for equipment, coaching and additional support for travel. Matt has also been away in Malaysia playing in the MPI Generali Amateur Championships playing alongside Asia's leading amateur players. In a field of 120 Matt finished the top Kiwi in 12th spot despite the very humid conditions where players not used to 35+ temps typically dropped shots late in their rounds as the heat took its toll. Next on Matt's golfing journey is the Mexican International Amateur Championships at the Club Golf De Mexico in Mexico City from June 7th to 10th. The trip is fully-funded by NZ Golf where Matt will be joined by Kerry Mountcastle. Keep up the great progress Matt and "Buena Suerte en México"!
