### **AGM 2018**

A very positive AGM was held on Tuesday evening with around 75 members in attendance. Some of the key points from the AGM were;

- After 10 years on the Board (5 as Chair) Mike Rondel was not seeking re-election. He was thanked for his considerable efforts and contribution to the Club during that time
- Phil Badger, Debbie Scott and Jamie Mountier were elected to the Board
- Doug Claridge confirmed as Club Captain
- There will be no change to member subscriptions for the 2018/19 year
- The new member special sub of \$995 and 20% introduction discount will remain in place
- A new “Woody” campaign is underway with a target of 100 new members this subs year
- We have been unable to secure enough sponsorship to hold the Jennian Homes Charles Tour Harewood Open this year so the 2018 event in October has been cancelled
- We have applied for an On-License which will remove some of the compliance issues we faced with our current Club License now we are seeing an increase in conference and function business
- We have started development of a new Club website and phase 2 of this will be a new retail system in the pro shop and bar
- We are re-negotiating our lease terms with CIAL to tidy-up a number of aspects on more favourable terms, particularly an extension of the term and reduction in the lease fee
- From September 1<sup>st</sup> we have introduced a \$10 fee for Templeton members using their reciprocal cards here – our members will be charged this also when playing there using the reciprocal card. Waimairi Beach and Bottle Lake remain unchanged.


